The Rev. Dr. Carol E. Lytch is the president of Lancaster Theological Seminary, one of the seven seminaries of the United Church of Christ. She came to this position from executive leadership in the Association of Theological Schools, an agency that accredits theological seminaries in the US and Canada. She has served as a pastor in Cranbury, NJ, adjunct faculty at Louisville Presbyterian Seminary, and coordinator of grant programs for theological schools at Lilly Endowment. She holds a BA from Mount Holyoke College, MDiv from Princeton Theological Seminary and PhD from Emory University in sociology of religion and Christian ethics. She is the author of *Choosing Church: What Makes a Difference to Teens?* (Westminster/John Knox, 2004). Married to The Rev. Dr. Stephens G. Lytch, they have two adult children, Katherine Lytch who lives in Madrid, Spain with her husband and son, and William Lytch who lives in Austin, TX.
