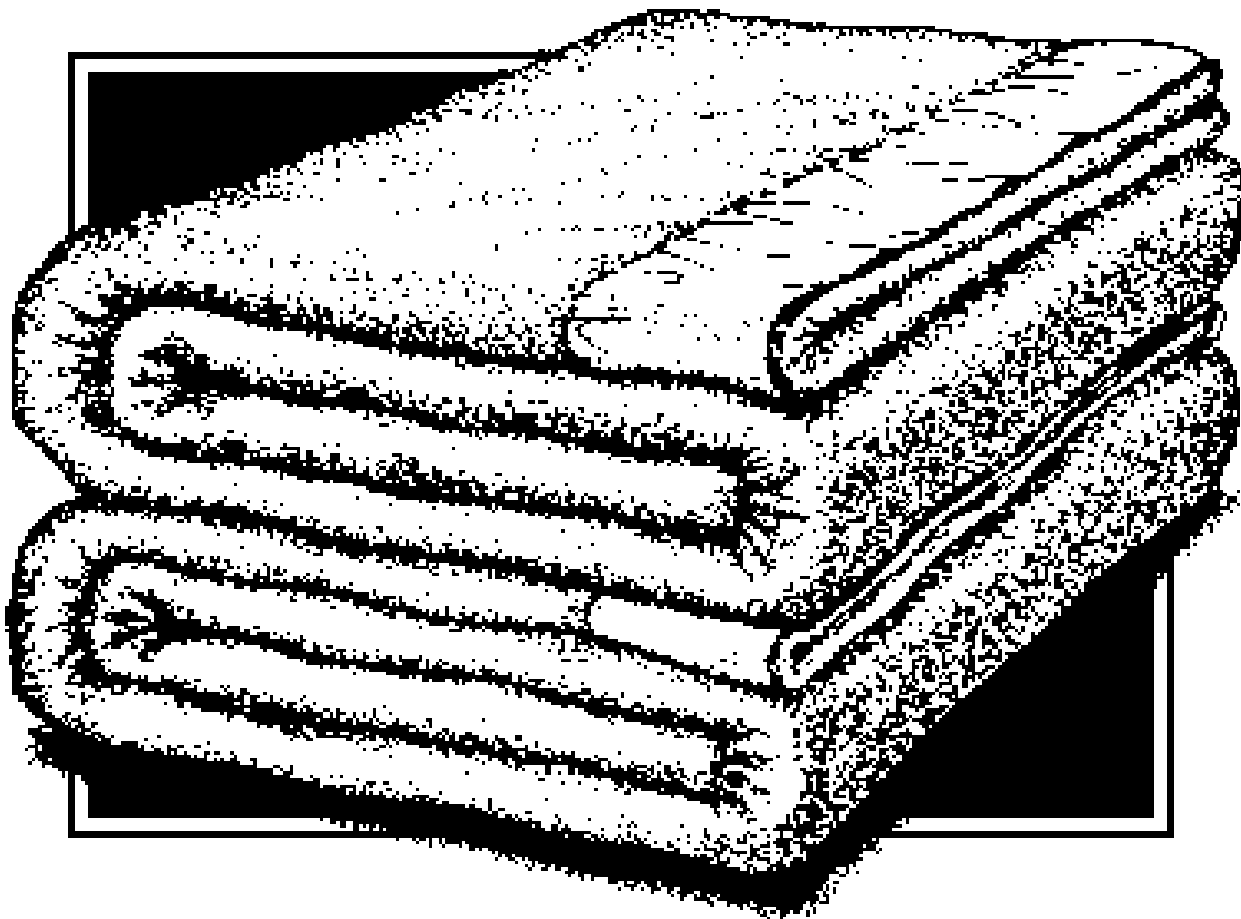

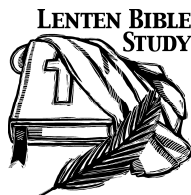

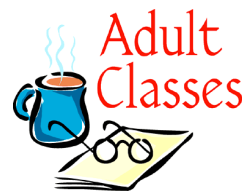


From the Property Committee:
