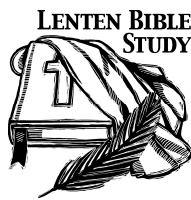

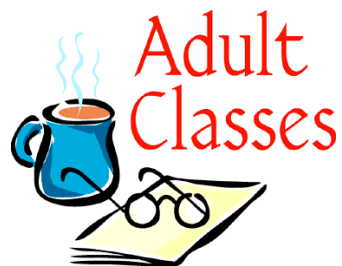
Mid-Morning Ash Wednesday Service
